# **Cell Tower at Scamman's Home and Garden Property**

The planning board did not vote in favor of the proposed cell tower at the property at 57 Portsmouth Avenue. It is possible there may be an appeal.

The developer is moving forward with state permitting for the residential development at the Breslin property on Heights Road.

## **Budget Meetings Underway**

The Stratham Budget committee is working with committees to create a budget for the upcoming year. Deliberative session will be held at Exeter High School to discuss the school committee budget for the SAU16 junior high school renovation and expansion located in Stratham.

## **Batchelder Easement Monitoring Report from RCCD**

Mark Morong code enforcement officer, Tavis Austin planner, and property owner John OBrien walked the easement border together to evaluate easement infringements by the neighbor. The RCCD monitoring report for the Batchelder property easement at 3 Barker Lane (57 acres) dated Dec 2016, identified debris dumping on the easement by a neighbor. The report included photos of fencing and other materials being stored there.

Morong explained that maintaining the easement was the property owners' responsibility. Morong will write a letter to the property owner, who should inform the neighbor responsible for dumping.
