

LOCATION

Nestled between Interstate 95 on the seacoast and I93 through the central corridor of New Hampshire, Stratham is bordered along the south by the newly extended and enlarged multi-lane thruway State Route 101 which connects the two interstates from east to west. The central corridor of Town is served north and south by State Routes 108 and 33.

The Town of Stratham is located approximately 30 miles from Manchester, NH, 50 miles northeast of Boston, MA and 60 miles southwest of Portland, ME.
