- **c.** Conditional Use Permit request by *Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) d/b/a Eversource*, represented by Kristopher Wilkes, VHB, for utility structure upgrades with associated wetland buffer impacts along existing PSNH Right-of-way, Tax Map 15 Lot(s) 73, 75, 77, 78 & 84.
