Senior Programing- Programs continue to be full. Upcoming trips- Portsmouth Music hall and Portland Orchestra; both sold out. New programs added including yoga taught by Diane. Upcoming activities- December luncheon, cookie swap and 2 Boxwood Tree activities. Youth Sports- Basketball registration closed 197 registered participants. Two training sessions held for coaches. Soccer survey was sent to participants -overall good feedback TMAC- Held a meet and greet with animal control officer open to the public. New Temporary signage to be put on private property reminding users dogs must be on leash; more signs have been ordered.

Stratham Hill Park- Baseball field work almost completed, including removal of baseball mounds. Pump track- mowing of pump track to be included in schedule for DPW 2024. Stevens park- Test pits completed; Brent, Seth, and Jay Flagg met to look at scope of project. Scope of project, to be reviewed by select board at December meeting. Pickleball committee forming; 25 people attended information meeting. Group discussed need for more courts as there continues to be scheduling challenges between user groups.

Fall programing- White Pine Wilderness Education program started in November; sold out. Still in talks with Timbernook about programing.

Winter programing- Pats Peak ski program for 7th-12th graders sold out. Registration for McIntyre K-6th ski program is open.

Recreation Department Staff- Diane started recently, she is adding programs and meeting with seniors to determine what they want.

Zach Cherry is nearing 6 months in position.

Seth attended a Financial Sustainability certification program in Concord.

Recreation Commission-Seth met with Legal Counsel to review liability to the town in operating a van. Based on recommendations from Primex the Departments program waivers have been reviewed and revised by Legal Counsel. Select board approval needed.
