It was suggested that the Committee decide whether it makes sense to study providing water only vs. providing water and sewer. Should they be bundled? How can sewer be considered without the framework of an agreement with Exeter or any other Town?

It was also suggested that the group look at the tax rate and the contribution of the industrial park. Has industrial development kept the tax rate stable and has that ended because the park has reached capacity?

M Currier and N Merrill will work to further refine the goals and the Committee will consider them at the next meeting.

Discussion of UNH extension service and public surveys. Should the Committee meet with developers to get an idea of Gateway District potential?
