## CHAPTER 1-06—USE OF UNUSED PORTIONS OF TOWN DEAD END ROADS

1-06-01 In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Stratham and other travelers upon public ways in the Town of Stratham which are dead-end roads, the Stratham Board of Selectmen authorizes and empowers the Stratham Police Department, in its discretion, to place barricades on those portions of any dead-end roads which are uninhabited and unoccupied and, therefore, not patrolled by the Stratham Police Department to prevent travel upon such portions of said dead-end roads in order to prevent personal injury and property damage.
