CHAPTER 1-15—NOISE

- 1-15-01 Realizing there are certain periods of time during a day where excessive, unnecessary, unnatural, and/or unusually loud noises which are prolonged, unusual and unnatural in their time, place, use and effect and are detrimental to the general public and;
- 1-15-02 It serves a legitimate public purpose to regulate noises which cause discomfort or annoyance to the reasonable persons of normal sensitiveness or which endanger the comfort, repose, health or peace of individuals in lawful proximity to the generator of such sounds;
- 1-15-03 The Board of Selectmen shall make it unlawful to cause or generate sound and/or noise which penetrates beyond the boundaries of the noisemakers' own premises and constitutes an unreasonable disturbance to people lawfully on those premises. Such a disturbance will be considered a nuisance as defined in the Town's Zoning Ordinance under Section 5.2.2 if it occurs between 10:00 pm and 6:00 am.
