PREAMBLE

The Stratham School Board is interested in the quality of education for Stratham children. The Stratham teachers share this interest. Both strive together for the progress of the children's education.

2) For the purposes of collective negotiations the Stratham School Board recognizes the Stratham Teachers Association as the exclusive representative of all the professional employees of the Stratham School District.

Professional employees shall include any individual employed full time by the Stratham School District, the qualifications for whose position are such as to require him/her to hold an appropriate teaching credential issued by the State Board of Education under its regulations governing the certification of professional school personnel. Any person holding provisional certification shall be considered to have appropriate teaching credential.

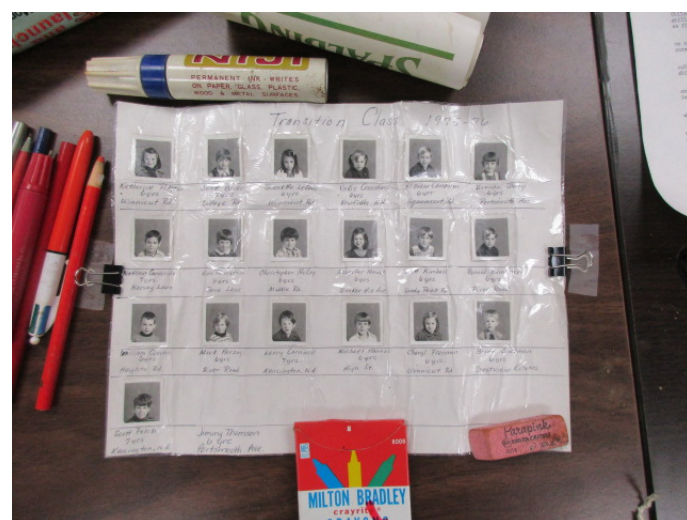

3)	The Stratham School District will provide its full-time teachers who enroll in the S.U. 416 New Hampshire/Vermont Blue Cross/blue Shield Insurance Plan of comparable policy, agreeable to the District, 100% payment of the individual premium regardless of the rate in force at the adoption of this agreement. Each teacher shall have the option to increase the policy coverage at no cost to the District.
4)	A teacher who has been in the system at least one semester will be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$200 for a one year period for college credits toward a program of improved teaching ability. This will be paid upon the satisfactory completion of the work, submission of proof of amount of tuition and fees expended and upon the recommendation of the Superintendent. The course or courses must be approved in advance by the Superintendent in order for the teacher to qualify under this provision.
5)	Each full-time teacher is entitled to fifteen (15) days sick leave cumulative to sixty (60) days. In addition, each full-time teacher has three (3) days emergency leave for death in the family, family illness, etc. subject to the approval of the principal and the superintendent. Emergency leave is noncumulative.
6)	Non-degree teachers with eight (8) years of experience in the Stratham School District will be considered to hold the B.A. degree for salary purposes. Other non-degree teachers will receive an annual contract salary set by the School Board.
7)	The School Board reserves the right to withhold a teacher's annual salary increment for good cause.

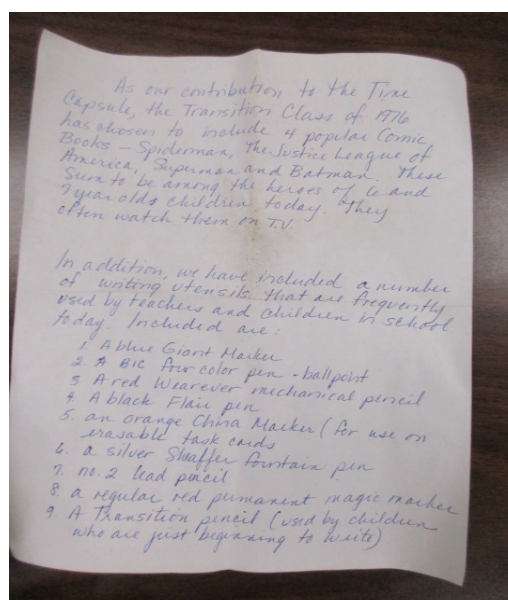

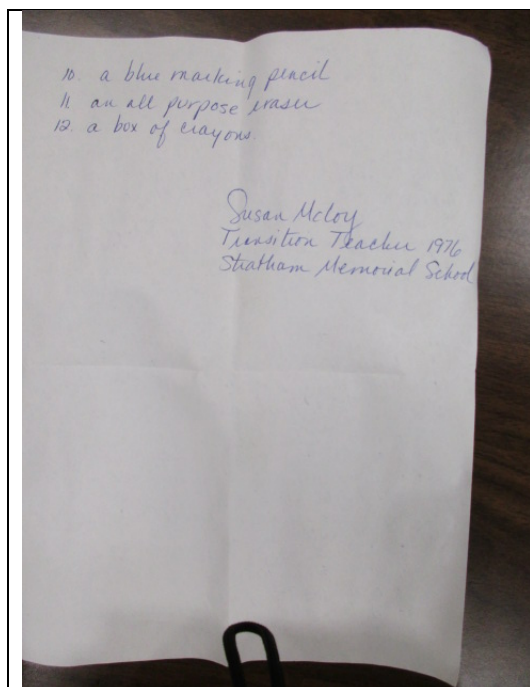
