The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) included the Signalization, Turn Lanes, and Intersection Realignment at the **NH108 / Bunker Hill Intersection** on its Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan for nearly ten years.

There are public hearings scheduled across the state in September and October to discuss the NHDOT's 10-year Plan and projects in the region. The purpose of these hearings is to gather public comments and testimonies on transportation projects and priorities included in the draft 2027-2036 Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan, as recommended by NHDOT to the Governor's Advisory Council on Intermodal Transportation (GACIT).
