

ACTION SUMMARY

April 21, 2025 Select Board Meeting

1. Minutes of 4/7/25 were approved
2. By a 2 to 1 vote, the Town Administrator was authorized to dispose of the #220 Police Cruiser at auction.
3. By a 2 to 1 vote, \$25,000 was authorized to be withdrawn from the CIP for the purchase of a Police cruiser.
4. By a 2 to 1 vote, the remaining funds to pay for the Police cruiser were authorized to come out of the Police Detail account.
5. Sgt. John Emerson's resignation was accepted with regret.
6. The Town Administrator was authorized to work with Public Works to approve the final layout for the Stratham Community Garden.
7. The Board will take both of Whitney Consulting's proposals into consideration for action at a later date.
8. The Board will review the proposed Sewall Room Policy and take it up again at the 5/19 meeting.
9. Jason Durrance, Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer, was named as Stratham's Health Officer.
10. The Board decided to take advantage of a \$70,000 grant for the purchase of a loader for DPW.
