

CHAPTER 1-05—PROHIBITED PRACTICES IN PUBLIC PLACES

1-05-01 It shall be unlawful for any person to have a weapon in his or her possession at any time while within any public building. Exceptions are as follows:

- 1) The prohibitions established by this ordinance shall not apply to bona fide federal, state or local law enforcement officials.
- 2) The Chief of Police is authorized to grant advance written permission to allow individuals or organizations demonstrating good reason to possess a weapon within a public building with permission to do so under such terms and conditions as the Chief may establish.

1-05-02 The penalty for violation of this provision shall be five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per occurrence.
