Background:

Rockingham Dispatch upgraded their radio system and during their upgrades Motorola told them that all the upgrade would work. However they didn't work and now Motorola has offered to allow municipalities to purchase new radios at 50% cost and they are covering the installation fees. The Stratham Fire Department truck radios are beyond service and we have been told by 2-Way Communications that they may be able to perform small repairs however if something does go wrong they would need to be replaced.

With the recent information regarding the upgrades at Rockingham and discount that Motorola is offering I recommend that we replace all the fire department radios.
