Subject: 2011 Ford F-350 Estimated Trade in Value

Good Evening,

I just returned from Quirk Chevrolet as The Board of Selectmen requested an approximate trade in value for truck 101, the 2011 Ford F-350. I was told the vehicle would have a trade in value of \$16,500.00 A few factors play into that cost and they are as follows.

- 1. The price is based on an approximate mileage. The vehicle has approximately 58,000 miles on it currently. Based on our use, I stated that when the vehicle is potentially traded it will have as much as 63,000 miles on it.
- 2. The proposed cab and chassis will be ordered after Town Meeting and will take 9 to 11 weeks to come in. Approximate time of arrival would be the middle of May.
- 3. I was told from a sales perspective, a "plow truck" new or used has a higher value now or in the fall before snow season.

As I mentioned, I think the vehicle could be sold privately for 20-25K and we will notify the potential buyer of problems we've had with the vehicle. If we do trade the vehicle to the dealer it is an as is trade and we don't necessarily have to disclose all the issues we've had with the vehicle. I don't think it's a great trade in price but I do think it's a fair trade in price for a dealer.

If the Board of Selectmen chose to trade this vehicle, it will bring the new 2017 Chevrolet 3500HD cab and chassis price down from \$34,887 to \$18,387. \$42,040 Total price with the truck body and equipment.
