 - a. Approved with fix needed for date on minutes.
- 2.) Solar Update @ Stratham PD
 - a. Snow fencing to be installed in January.
 - b. Mike investigated install with these most recent storms. No abrupt snowfall from the roof was witnessed. SPD coned off snowfall areas as a precaution.
- 3.) LES Conference update
 - a. Saw Glenn Shwaery's presentation of solar panel coating potential.
 - b. M-W production of SPD system was zero because of snow cover. Future tech to provide shielding that will quicken moisture removal.
 - c. Local Energy Exchange showed promise for regional cooperative opportunities.
 - d. PUC still working on requirements and regs for group netmetering.
 - e. EV Charging Planning opportunities Level 2 costs anywhere from \$1-6K.
 - i. Towns trying to accommodate to foster tourism and to standardize for installations.
 - ii. 2 plug types: Tesla v Standard (Teslas come with adapters to use standard plugs)
 - iii. Current in Stratham: 126 Hybrids; 26 EV (of which 16 are Tesla)-Check if H or E on registration
