 - a. Met with legal review of design requirements.
 - b. Chief will be investigating snow management options, including additional snow fencing.

 - a. Not well developed at this point.
- 4.) RPC Procurement
 - a. Aggregate Purchasing Benefit from bringing in more communities now and into the future. First time process for the planning commission but should yield more successes in future solicitations.
 - b. Bid Process Results last week, presented today Stratham, Newfields, Hampton Falls, Epping Schools, Newton, Plaistow library, Kingston
 - c. 400K KWH for Stratham-Constellation
 - i. 12 mo was 7.53 (most recent 12 mo Default Tariff was 8.5)
 - 1. Similar pricing comparisons from both Mike R and Mike W looking at 12 month terms.
 - ii. 24 mo 7.34
 - iii. 36 mo 7.22 (Annual savings \$5,272. \$500/yr savings vs 24 month price)
 - d. Select Board Meeting 9-23-19
 - i. Sign contract by 9/25
 - ii. Mike R and Matt to attend (7pm start)

 - a. Lester Cuff at last meeting to encourage more renewable energy options for Stratham.
