The group is charged with recommending concrete feedback and a work plan structure for SHP to ensure it is protected in perpetuity.


#### **Community Support & Enjoyment**

Including the public in the management of this kind of resource is challenging but necessary.


With multiple user groups it becomes imperative that we include as many stakeholders in the process as possible.



### TMAC Timeline 2021




