

Lights 4 Lives (L4L) is back for its 8th year helping a family or charity in need in Stratham, NH! We are very excited to be partnering with Gabriel Chambers and his family for 2021. Gabriel is a loving and happy 9-year-old boy who attends Stratham Memorial School. He was born with Angelman Syndrome (AS), a very rare neuro-genetic disorder that occurs in approximately one in 15,000 births globally. Individuals with AS face significant challenges including motor difficulties, cognitive impairment, seizures and an almost complete loss of functional speech.

L4L hopes to raise funds for research as well as awareness of Angelman Syndrome through online donations and raffles. Raffle items include 4 round trip airline tickets (\$1,800 value), a horticulture gift card tree (approximate value \$1,200), a restaurant gift card tree (approximate value \$800), and a Lowes full size tool chest!
