#### Recap conversation with The Rim (Cantrece)

#### Update on other towns 2021/22 plan (Cantrece)

- Email was sent to towns who previously participated in the Seacoast League. Responses were received from Greenland, East Kingston, Kensington & North Hampton. Overall they enjoyed the league and would like to see it continue but not one town offered to setup and facilitate the league. They are also struggling with volunteer board participation.
