Sullivan subdivision on High St. now plans for a cul-de-sac without a through connection due to abutter and Sullivan family concerns. Audi will come with a revised site plan that is to include side walks. 110 Grill has applied for a building permit, and Butcher shop is creating a formal area to serve food.

Kim Woods has resigned as Park Ranger and John Dodge is now a part time assistant at the Park.

Rob Roseen is now an alternate on the Planning Board.

Forestry Work on Stratham Hill:
