Dear Trustees of the Trust Funds,

We are requesting that 25,275.00 be released from the Cemetery Trust Fund. The funds requested are to be taken from accumulated interest. Currently there is \$123,195.00 in accumulated interest and 271,965.00 in principle. The total trust fund amount is \$395,160.00

These funds will be used for the following at the Maple Lane Cemetery. All proposed funds will be used for perpetual care within the Town Cemeteries.

Eleven maple trees are in need of pruning within the cemetery grassy areas. We are proposing to thin the tree crowns to promote better overall health of the trees along with allowing additional sunlight onto the grassy areas and promote turf grass growth.

22 Norway spruce trees are in need of being removed. These trees pose a great threat to public safety, and cemetery plots (headstone) damage. In the past two years a total 5 large Norway spruce trees in wind storms. The trees appear to be healthy in most areas however they have become so tall that when the wind hits them the tops snap off leaving approximately 10 to 15 feet in place on the stump.

Attached please find a map which outlines the work proposed. We do plan on planting 4 Maple trees in place of the Norway spruce trees which will provide shade to the area. This area is irrigated which will help the trees to establish during dry periods. The Maple trees will not get as tall as the existing Norway spruce trees which will make them a lot less susceptible to wind damage. The cost to install the Maple trees is \$2,000.00
