

2021 Pats Peak Ski & Snowboard Program

New this year.... this five (5) week program is being offered to 1st - 12th graders (Must be 6 by 1/1/21) in our community. The Stratham Recreation Department is excited to offer a ski program during these difficult times. Due to the current pandemic we WILL NOT be offering transportation to/from the mountain like we have in past years. Participants are on their own with transportation to/from the mountain each Wednesday and transporting their own equipment. Stratham Parks and Recreation WILL have chaperones on the mountain to ensure a safe and successful program but participants will be skiing without constant adult supervision.

Registration ~ **Step 1**

- Visit RecDesk> https://stratham.recdesk.com
- All participants will need to create an account (or use an existing account) within Stratham's RecDesk website.
- Select "Programs"
- Add to cart "Pat's Peak 2021 Ski Program (step 1)" to your cart
 - No fee for step 1 in the registration process

Registrations will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. If the program fills, please be sure to add information to the waiting list, we will pull off that list in order "if" slots become available.

Registration ~ Step 2

Stratham Parks & Recreation will reach out <u>to "step 1" registered participants</u> via email on November 2nd to completed Step 2 of registration.

Please allow sufficient time when registering to enter all medical and emergency contact information. This information is vital in the event of injuries. Please be sure to updated parent contact information to include cell and home numbers and email addresses.

Please be advised and understand that Pats Peak and the Stratham Parks and Recreation Department are NOT able to issue refunds or transfers due to student schedule conflicts to including athletic team schedules.

Failure to complete step 2 of the registration process by November 23rd will result in the loss of your confirmed spot in the program.

CHAPERONES/VOLUNTEERS: This is a volunteer-based program and the Stratham Parks and Recreation Department IS IN NEED of CHAPERONES for the 2021 program. We are asking that chaperones commit to attending ALL five (5) weeks of the program. It is not necessary that you ski or ride to be a chaperone but you must be at least 21 years old. All chaperones will be provided a FREE lift pass for the time they are chaperoning at the mountain. Please note due to the current pandemic the lodge will have limited space for those not skiing. GROUP SIZE: The Stratham Parks and Recreation Department is able to accommodate *a maximum of* **150 students** in the program. Registrations accepted online on a first come first serve basis.

HELMETS ARE MANDATORY IN THIS PROGRAM: Helmet rental & helmet purchase are both available during the Pats Peak registration process.

BONUS DAY: Included with your program registration, the bonus day has become a traditional part of the Pats Peak Program. Valid beginning on February 22, 2021 through the end of 2021 season, just bring your laminated lift tag to the ski school desk and trade it in for an ALL DAY/ALL LIFT ticket, weekends included. Again, this season, students may bring their laminated tags to Pats Peak, Bretton Woods or Waterville Valley Resort. Details will be included in our program welcome letter sent out in December.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Pats Peak provides our program two complete scholarships that include lift ticket, lessons if elected and rentals if needed. Scholarship information will be held in strict confidentiality. Please contact the Stratham Parks and Recreation Department for qualifying criteria. Requests will be handled on a first come first serve basis. We hope this helps those students who otherwise would not be able to participate in the program.
